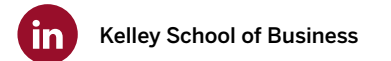

How to Apply

1. Apply to Indiana University and select one of the Kelley School of Business majors on your IU application.
To maximize scholarship consideration, submit a complete application by November 1.
2. Earn Kelley Direct Admission: gokelley.iu.edu/direct
3. To ensure consideration for the Kelley Dean's Council Scholarship, complete the William R. Fry Scholarship application. Students will be considered for both awards but may only receive one. gokelley.iu.edu/fry
4. Consider applying for the Hudson & Holland Scholars Program, which includes a financial award and academic support. Kelley Dean's Council Scholars receive special consideration for Hudson & Holland.
